



WHAT WILL THE CENTER BE USED FOR?

A new women's outreach center in the heart of Tijuana. They are providing weekly outreach to women on the streets of Tijuana- they have mobilized 2+ FT workers who have prayed and connected with over 300 women on the streets inviting them to Bible study and opportunities for new work. Though the work is slow and arduous, some women have already been relocated and restored to their families.



CITYLIGHT PRESCHOOL

Citylight Preschool aims to provide spiritual and educational formation to children in our community. We bridge communities with children of all backgrounds and integrate curriculum to provide holistic Christian education that will equip children with foundations for their future.





When we first met Zulma and Katerin, they had only been in the United States for 8 months. They moved from El Salvador and were really missing some of their family members, including Katerin's 9 year old brother that had to stay back in El Salvador. Katerin stayed mostly inside during the day, could barely hold a crayon, and did not know any of her colors or numbers even in her native language, Spanish. When she first came to the Preschool open house, she sat in the corner of the play kitchen in complete culture shock watching the other English-speaking children play.

Over the next couple months, we were able to meet with Mom every week doing home visits. Mom had an amazing connection with Katerin, she just had never thought about teaching Katerin basic pre-kindergarten skills. We provided strategies for Mom to teach Katerin her colors, numbers, writing and reading skills. We were able to provide crayons, scissors, books, and activities for mom to do with Katerin. Mom started to set aside time each day for Katerin to learn. Soon enough, Katerin found a passion for coloring, and quickly not only began to hold the crayon better, but could color within the lines and even draw her own stick figures! She also began to trace numbers and letters. - Kristy Lapp, Home Visit Director.




Simply, it has helped me learn how to disciple others by being a disciple of those who are disciples of Jesus Christ the Son of God.




I came to serve because I wanted to be around my brothers and sisters in Christ, and be in community I know I needed. I also was able to invite the families that I deliver meals to every month.





Citylight middle school launched on Sunday mornings. We have 8 kids who consistently attend.

Money Given to Missions & Global Outreach: \$400,000+



In Northern India, Ravi Sharmawas leading two churches in Delhi and in the last 3 years worked to support pastors ready to quit, now leading a network of over 12 churches. They have seen dozens of former Hindus baptized. During one season of fasting, prayer, and outreach in 2022 they shared the gospel with over 10,000 people.




